
**The Wright-Dunbar Visitor Center** - The Wright Dunbar Interpretive Center, located in the same building where the Wright Brothers operated their printing business, showcases exhibits that explore the lives of the brothers and Orville's high school classmate, poet Paul Laurence Dunbar. Learn about the life and legacies of these three men through a film and fascinating hands on displays.

**The Wright Cycle Company** - The 4th location of the bicycle shop operated by the Wrights is the only building remaining as a testament to their bicycle business. It was designated a National Historical Landmark in 1990. It is also where the Wright Brothers first dreamt of man in flight.



Explore 30 historical buildings spread across **Carillon Historical Park**. See the original 1905 Wright Flyer III, Dayton-made cash registers, train cars, automobiles and bicycles, the largest carillon in Ohio and ride the Carousel of Dayton Innovation.

The new **Carillon Brewing Co.** at Carillon Historical Park is the only museum in the U.S. to produce and sell beer using techniques from the 1800's.
