9:00AM

Immerse yourself in the world of **Winans Chocolates + Coffees**. In its fourth generation of ownership, Winans has been in service since 1929. You will learn the family's history while seeing how their chocolates are made. You'll get to even sample some sweet treats and coffees.

Stillwater Prairie Reserve is situated along the scenic Stillwater River. A circular hiking trail with segments following the river also passes through fields, woodlands, marshy habitats, and shrub lands. There are three man-made ponds and the river providing fishing opportunities as well.
