ITINERARY

DAY 1

In Dennison, the **Dennison Railroad Depot Museum** makes for an excellent springboard into your group's visit to the Northeast. Here, they'll explore the rich history of railroading at one of the best-preserved railroad depots in the country. For more regional history, go next to **Zoar Village**. Settled in 1817, this National Historic Landmark offers both self-guided and guided tours featuring its restored buildings, a public garden, and the preserved Zoar Store, the commercial center of the 19th-century community. The **MAPS Air Museum** (Military Aviation Preservation Society) in North Canton is a great place for the aviation fans of your group to explore military and aircraft history. Finally, end your day in the nearby village of **Hartsville** for an evening of shopping at quaint shops and enjoying a meal at one out of many delicious eatery choices.

DAY 2

The art buffs of your group will love a visit to the **Butler Museum of Art** in Youngstown, where narrative works from artists such as Edward Hopper and Georgia O'Keeffe are featured among its permanent collection. Then, treat the group's fashionistas with a visit to the **Kent Fashion Museum**, which showcases the evolution of fashion through exhibits and displays. Take your tourgoers back in time with a visit to **Hower House** or **Stan Hywet Hall**, two historic mansions in Akron that offer tours showcasing elegant architecture and extensive gardens. Wrap up the day in the city of Medina and explore its historic **Public Square**, where your tourgoers can get in the holiday spirit at **Castle Noel**. This year-round Christmas attraction boasts 40,000 square feet of holiday fun, including props from beloved Christmas films, and groups can book a festive dinner following their memorable visit.

DAY 3

Wow the animal lovers of your group with a visit to **Greater Cleveland Aquarium**, featuring seven galleries that boast eye-level and 360-degree views of more than 1,300 freshwater and saltwater animals from around the globe. Next, take some time to explore **University Circle**, a vibrant cultural district that's home to several museums. Or, wander the streets of **Little Italy**, known for its vibrant restaurants and cafes. And no visit to Cleveland is complete without a tour of the **Rock & Roll Hall of Fame**, which celebrates the history and evolution of rock music through interactive exhibits and authentic memorabilia. For an activity-based experience, stop by **Pinstripes** in Beachwood for brews, bowling, and bocce. Conclude your group's tour of Northeast Ohio with a luxury dinner cruise aboard the **Lady Caroline**, offering stunning views of Cleveland's skyline and the gorgeous Lake Erie.
