ITINERARY

DAY 1

For groups looking to explore the Southwest region of the Buckeye State, start things off in Clermont County with brunch at Weiss Baking Co., where made-from-scratch bakery goodies take center stage. From there, depart for Cincinnati, where your group can partake in a tour and cooking demonstration at Findlay Market, which has operated downtown continuously since 1855 and today welcomes more than 1 million visitors per year. Next, journey to Jungle Jim's International Market in Fairfield for an afternoon of wine tasting and a scavenger hunt. Sit down for dinner at Tano Bistro in Hamilton to enjoy a seasonally crafted menu that highlights local produce and sustainable ingredients, all presented in a warm and modern dining space. Finally, settle in for a relaxing and restful night at Courtyard Hamilton.

DAY 2

Your group's next-morning activity will take place right at the hotel, with a doughnut-making demonstration from the Butler County Donut Trail. Afterward, depart for Mullen Dairy & Creamery, a working dairy farm founded in 1898 that also features shopping, farm tours, and even Calf Yoga! Your group's next stop is Dayton. Carillon Brewing Co. is a stop you'll want to make, not only for lunch and a refreshing beverage but also for some fascinating history. This production brewery within a museum offers a look at the food and drink of 1850s Dayton, complete with costumed interpreters. Indulge in dinner at **Coco's Bistro**, featuring a lively menu of delicious American fare in an elegant setting with a variety of pleasant seating options. Spend the night at **Hotel Ardent** Dayton Downtown, Tapestry Collection by Hilton.

DAY 3

For your group's final day in Ohio's Southwest region, enjoy a savory breakfast at Dayton's **Second Street** Market, an experience modeled after European markets featuring local vendors, bakers, farmers, and more. Next, head north for Troy. Once there, treat your group to a pick-me-up at Purebred Coffee Co. Enjoy specialty coffees and beans roasted in-house in a recently expanded downtown space. Take your pick of any number of lunch spots downtown before heading to Indian Creek Distillery for a tour and tasting to experience its several varieties of small-batch whiskey. End your group's trip back in downtown Troy with charcuterie and drinks at **Crafted & Cured**. Enjoy a local craft beer or artisan cocktail while perusing old photographs of the space's former life as a bank building, and take in a little bit of Troy's historic past.
